Purpose of the manual

The purpose of this manual is to guide the qualified installer the installation, maintenance and proper and safe use of the equipment.

Intended use

The Unisenza PLUS Gateway is an ideal solution for connecting multiple devices to the cloud through an Internet router with WiFi or Ethernet cable connection. It is ZigBee 3.0 and connects up to 100 end devices such as smart room thermostats, radiator valve controllers (TRV), relaybox/receiver, and sensors, etc.

Its features are:

- ZigBee 3.0
- BLE (Bluetooth Low Energy) wifi provisioning
- 802.11 b/g/n WiFi connection
- 10/100Mbps Ethernet connection

- Over the air firmware update capability
- Powered by 5VDC thru Micro-USB port
- Wall mountable (with the wall mount bracket)





LED functions



LED	Status	Description
Cloud	Green	Gateway is connected to the cloud.
	Orange	Gateway has lost connection to the cloud.
LAN/WiFi	Green	Gateway is connected to the local network via Ethernet cable or WiFi.
	Red	Local network connection is not established.
ZigBee	Green	Normal status.
	Green Flash	Identifying the joined ZigBee devices.
	Orange	Ready for ZigBee devices to join the gateway.
	Orange Flash	Reach the max. number of ZigBee devices.



If Ethernet cable is connected but LAN/WiFi LED is Red, please check your cable connection or router setting.

6 DOWNLOAD THE APP FOR GATEWAY MANAGEMENT




The management of the **Unisenza PLUS Gateway** is also possible through a dedicated APP that allows its configuration, connection to your home internet network and the management of the devices you will pair.

In order to download the **APP**, you need to connect to the **STORE** of your device used for configuration and install the **Unisenza Plus**.

On the bask side of the **Gateway** there are two labels, one indicates the Mac Address (A) of the device with its **QR code** next to it and one the Device ID (B) also with the relative **QR code** next to it.








Wall installation


With the use of the plate for wall installation it will be possible to position the **Unisenza PLUS Gateway** in two different ways:



Fix the plate to the wall according to how you want to position the **Gateway**.




For convenience we will continue to illustrate the vertical wall installation of the Gateway; the operations for the horizontal one are the same, but considering the Gateway rotated.



Support installation

Thanks to the four rubber feet on the back side, it is possible to place the **Unisenza PLUS Gateway** on a furniture piece, table or desk.







Register the Gateway to the Cloud

The **Gateway** can be connected to your router by either **Ethernet (LAN)** or by **WiFi**. It will use Ethernet to connect to the cloud when both Ethernet and WiFi connections are available.

By Ethernet (LAN)









If you choose to connect the **Gateway** using a **QR code**, frame the label of the **Mac Address** on the back side of the device.

LAN/WiFi





Continue to follow the instructions to register the **Gateway**.


Join Unisenza PLUS devices to the Gateway

Using APP






- On Unisenza PLUS device, follow user guide instructions to enter joining mode.
- Complete the joining process by following the on screen instruction from the App. After successfully joined to the **Gateway**, the device information is shown on App dashboard.




Without APP




On Unisenza PLUS device, follow user guide instructions to enter joining mode.

- Press Top Button to exit after finished identification.


10 MAINTENANCE

Over-the-air (OTA) firmware update

The **Gateway** checks the server for newer version of firmware once it is connected to the Internet. It downloads and updates the new firmware automatically.

Power Cycle Reset


If for any reason the Gateway does not respond or requires a restart follow the procedure as below.




Factory Reset

12 DISPOSAL AT THE END OF LIFE



Pursuant to art. 13 of Decree-Law No. 49 of 2014 "Implementation of the WEEE Directive 2012/19/EU on waste electrical and electronic equipment".
